➤ **Interactive CBPR Conceptual Model (2011)**

Systematic literature review of instruments and measures in four components of the CBPR model: 1) contextual factors; 2) partner group dynamics; 3) the extent of community-centeredness in intervention and research design; and 4) the impact of these participatory processes on CBPR system change and health outcomes.
